The National Authority for the Campaign Against Alcohol and Drug Abuse is a State Corporation in the Ministry of Interior and Coordination of National Government. It was established by the NACADA Act of 2012 (CAP 121B) of the Laws of Kenya to coordinate a multi-sectoral effort aimed at preventing, controlling and mitigating alcohol and drug abuse in Kenya. NACADA is mandated to provide and facilitate the development and operation of rehabilitation facilities, programs and standards for persons suffering from substance use disorders. Certification of addictions professionals is one step in that direction. The objective is to ensure quality treatment and rehabilitation to persons with substance use disorders by certifying addiction professionals.

COURSE PURPOSE

To ensure that the Addiction Professionals acquire set competencies and skills thereby comply with the National Standards for Treatment and Rehabilitation of Persons with Substance Use Disorders

COURSE CONTENT

Phase 1

UTC 1: Introduction to the science of addiction
UTC 2: Treatment for SUDs- The continuum of care
UTC 3: Common co-occurring mental and medical disorders

Phase 2

UTC 4: Basic Counseling Skills for Addiction professionals
UTC 5: Intake, screening, Assessment, Treatment
Planning and documentation

Phase 3

UTC 6: Case management for Addiction professionals
UTC 7: Crisis Interventions for Addiction Professionals
UTC 8: Ethics for Addiction Professionals

TRAINING PROGRAMME

Phase 1 - November 2021

Phase 2 - February 2022

Phase 3 - May 2022

ELIGIBILITY

Degree in Social Sciences, Medicine, Education or related field (Pharmacy)

Diploma in Addiction Counselling, Psychology, Social Work, Education and Psychiatric Nursing

COST

The training cost is Ksh. 40,000 per phase (physical training) which will cater for course materials, information packs, snacks and lunch. For virtual training the cost will be Ksh. 20,000. During the training participants shall be expected to meet accommodation, travel and any other expenses. A certificate shall be awarded after every phase and upon successful completion and passing of the Basic UTC exam participants shall be accredited.

VENUE

In the FY 2021/22 The training shall be held in Nairobi
The specific venue shall be communicated to registered participants before commencement.
