



## SCHEDULE OF TRAININGS FOR ADA PREVENTION AND MANAGEMENT FOR THE YEAR 2021/2022

The National Authority for the Campaign against Alcohol and Drug Abuse (NACADA) was established through an Act of Parliamentary in 2012 and mandated to coordinate a multi-sectoral campaign aimed at preventing, controlling and mitigating the impact of alcohol and drug abuse in Kenya.

The overall goal of ADA prevention training is to reduce the health, social and economic problems associated with substance use by building prevention capacity on the most effective evidence-based preventive interventions and strategies by applying the key findings reported in the International Standards for Drug Use Prevention to 'real' world communities across the globe.

In this connection, NACADA has organized the following training programs to meet the needs of public sector employees.

<b>2. Online training</b>				
Online training is currently available for <b>Workplace Based Prevention Interventions for free (Committee members)</b> . The training is a combination of live online sessions and self-paced learning over 3weeks. Guidelines are available on the website. Training is scheduled once quorum is attained. Further information can be obtained from our training team.				
<b>3. In-house training</b>				
In house training - this means an individual institution organizes for the training and caters for the cost (conference, own staff subsistence allowance). NACADA will cater for its team's subsistence allowances. There should be a minimum of 10 participants to qualify for in-house training.
